

Smartt Baseball Camps Camp Guidelines for Summer 2020

Below are steps that Smartt Baseball Camps will have in place for our summer camps in 2020 in order to maintain the safest possible setting to play baseball.

- All Staff & Campers will have temperature checked each morning prior to camp. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 degrees or more will not be allowed to participate.
- Staff will be in masks during the check in and check out process.
- Campers may wear masks but will NOT be required.
- There will be a limit of 50 Campers for each session in order to maintain proper distancing during the camp.
- Campers are encouraged to bring their own bat and helmet to avoid sharing of the same equipment.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at Riddle-Pace Field.
- Campers should bring their own water bottle properly labeled with his name. Camp Staff will be available to refill bottles.
- Campers will be encouraged to avoid contact with other campers (high fives, horseplay, etc.) and to sneeze or cough into their elbow.
- Areas frequented by Campers will be properly cleaned between camp sessions.
- Only Staff and Campers will be allowed in the dugouts and on the playing surface of Riddle-Pace Field. Parents should maintain social distancing in the bleacher areas. In the event of an emergency, Camp Staff will be available to escort parents/guardians to the appropriate location.
